

2. LEG OUT LESSON

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Jeff Chimileski, March 2019

START POSITION: Load to division capacity. Shooter at P1, hands at sides.

Scenario: Some bad guys don't know the proper use of cover. Teach them a lesson! Keep your leg behind cover or suffer the consequences!

Scoring: Vickers (not limited)

Round Count: 14 minimum

Targets: 6 IDPA, 2 steel "legs"

Target distance: 5 to 10 yards.

Scored hits: Best 2 on each paper

Concealment garment: Required.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the signal, draw, use cover properly to fire 2 shots at each target, slicing the pie around each side of the barricade. Hidden T3 and T6 targets must shoot leg in order to expose target.

SETUP: T3 and T6 to fall toward the center of the range. Place non-threats angled in a manner to block the left side targets from the right side and vice versa.
